2. Visa

General information

Depending on your nationality, a visa might be required when intending to travel to France. All visas must be applied for prior to departure at the nearest French Embassy or French Consulate in the applicant's country of residence.

The type of visa required depends both on the duration and purpose of your stay in France: <u>tourism</u>, <u>professional purposes</u>, <u>studies</u>, <u>family purposes</u>.

For stays equal to, or shorter than 90 days:

• You will need to apply for a <u>short-stay visa</u>.

Regulations and types of visas vary according to the French territory you intend to visit:

- For European territory (mainland France), France complies with Schengen regulations related to the <u>Schengen area</u>, and issues a short-stay Uniform Schengen visa;
- For non-European territories (French overseas territories), France issues a short-stay national visa;
- If you intend to transit through a French airport without exiting the "international zone", please check whether you need to apply for an "A" airport transit Schengen visa.

3. Transport

For the purposes of the RoboCup, the organising committee, supported by Bordeaux metropole and Bordeaux convention bureau, undertakes to provide the participants with <u>free transport passes</u> for a period of 9 days (starting from the first validation). These passes will be given to the RoboCuper on the day of their check-in at the exhibition center, or at the « welcoming desks » installed at Bordeaux airport or at Bordeaux railway.

4. Accommodation



6. Telephony

Prepaid SIM cards do not require a subscription and only work with a top-up system when the phone or data credit is exceeded. These offers are ideal for travelers to be able to call or go online in certain countries without having to take out a subscription. There are several operators offering prepaid SIM cards, the prices of which can vary according to usage.



Here is what you need to know about prepaid SIM cards:

Prepaid SIM cards allow you to pay only for what you use in order to control your budget.

Some SIM cards allow you to have unlimited credit for a limited period of time.

Prepaid SIM top-ups have a limited validity period.

Prepaid SIM cards allow you to have a new phone number.

Orange, SFR, Bouygues Télécom, Lebara and Lyca offer prepaid SIM cards.

Many operators on the market sell prepaid SIM cards. This is the case for the three main operators, Orange, Bouygues Telecom and SFR. However, they are not the only ones to offer this type of service. Some MVNOs, such as Lebara, Lyca and La Poste mobile, also sell them.
